Windy City Hosts 2022 AGD Annual Meeting

The AGD Annual Meeting convened at the Hyatt McCormick Place in Chicago, November 10-13, 2022. At this gathering, the governing body of the AGD, the House of Delegates, assembles to consider resolutions which will affect our organization.

Each constituent sends delegates (as well as alternates) to vote on the various issues, and to elect officers.

Alabama's delegates included **Drs. Charles Betts, Mike Robinson, Ross Isbell, Bill Ingram, Bill Chesser,** and **Gary Myers.** In addition, a senior dental student, **Crystal Hanson**, attended as an AGD Alternate Delegate.



Preparation for this pivotal meeting for our constituent begins in October, with our Region 19 Pre-Caucus. This tradition was begun several years ago by Dr. Gordon Isbell. He rightly believed that our regional delegates need to prepare for this national meeting by being familiar with resolutions to be addressed by the HOD.

(Not all regions choose to do this, but your Editor thinks it is very helpful, resulting in our delegates being better informed on decisions which must be decided involving the future of dentistry. Sadly, some attendees are not as well prepared.)

By the way, Dr. Derrick Mendez was supposed to be serving as delegate for our state, but was unable to attend, due to illness. FYI, the first session of the HOD involves mostly speeches. This year, speakers were Gerald Botko, President of AGD, and George Shepley, ADA President. Officer candidates also gave brief addresses.

AGD National awards were presented during this assembly. Alabama is pleased to receive the William W. Howard ACE Award for our Composite Newsletter in Category Two (201-799 members). In addition, our state is proud to receive Honorable Mention for our work in Public Information.

Your Editor is disappointed in the way awards are now presented. In the past, the President would greet each recipient on stage to make the announcements. Now, announcements are made from the podium, and honorees gather in line for official photographs later. Sort of

Regional caucuses are held the second day. At this time, each region analyzes the many resolutions, decides the options available, and share opinions on voting choices. Sunday is the Third Session. At this time, the following officers were elected: Chethan Chetty, of California, Vice President; Joseph Picone, from Connecticut, Treasurer. Our 2022 President-Elect, Hans Gunter, automatically moves up into the Presidency.

The only resolution this year which exhibited conflicting opinions was that which involved the number of dental students a constituent could submit for selection of the required two alternate student delegates and two student delegates. 45 minutes of debate, editorial corrections, and substitutions later, the final decision was to leave the number at four, as before. A Noon Adjournment was much appreciated. Next year, we do it all over again.







The award is the highest honor given by the ADA's Board of Trustees, according to a June 21 news release.



program for dental school students and other scholarship programs. He also helped develop an annual ethics seminar at the University of Alabama School of Dentistry in Birmingham for third- and fourth-year students that has been in place for the last 20 years.







Each year, the constituents of the AGD are expected to submit an extensive report on the previous year's activities. At the annual House of Delegates session, awards are given out in 4 categories, as well as an overall Constituent of the Year award.
